

Interpretation of Privacy

Marlintrans Int'l Forwarding B.V. respects the privacy legislation. We appreciate the trust you've placed in us and ensure that the personal information you provide is treated confidentially. Your data, such as your name and e-mail addresses, will only be used in the context of our business communication.

We use your data to process your logistics order as quickly and properly as possible. We will only use this information with your permission. We will not sell your personal details to third parties and will only make them available to third parties if it is necessary for carrying out the logistic assignment. Our employees and third parties engaged by us are obliged to treat your data confidentially.

What are personal data?

Under the general personal data regulation (A.V.G.) the personal details are described as follows

"All information concerning an identified or identifiable natural person". This concerns, for example, your name, telephone number or e-mail address. You share your personal information with us if you are a customer with us or if you have contact with us.

What personal data do we process?

Marlintrans Int'l Forwarding mediates in logistics services. In order to provide you with the best possible service, we use the following personal information from you.

Name, address and e-mail address of the company where you work. The names and functions of you and your company are collected and saved.

We use your personal data for the following purpose

Communicate with you about the logistics assignments we receive from you.

With whom do we share personal data?

We will never share your personal data with third parties unless we are legally obliged to do so. The police, judiciary or tax authorities can legally request your information from us.

Storage period of data

Marlintrans does not store personal data longer than necessary for the purpose for which it was provided or required by law.

Security

We have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect personal data against unlawful processing, so the following measures apply:

- All persons within the company Marlintrans who are able to take note of personal data, are bound to confidentiality thereof in the employment contract;
- We use a password policy in all our systems;
- Our computer system is protected by "Eset Endpoint Antivirus" which is regularly updated automatically via a subscription;
- The personal data on paper are stored safely, under lock and key;
- The paper data is only available from the Marlintrans drivers;
- The business premises are secured with cameras, locked fences and placed under an alarm center;
- We as Marlintrans do not use digital marketing.

Data leaks will be reported to the Dutch Data Protection Authority.

Rights concerning your data

- You have the right to inspect, rectify or delete the personal data that we have received from you. You can also object to the processing of your personal data (or a part thereof) by us or by one of our processors. You also have the right to have the data provided by you transferred by us to yourself or by order of you directly to another party. We can ask you to identify you before we can comply with the aforementioned requests.
- We may process your personal data on the basis of a permission given by you, you always have the right to withdraw this consent.

Complaints

If you have a complaint about the processing of your personal data, we ask you to contact us directly. If we do not get together, we find this very annoying. However, you always have the right to submit a complaint to the Dutch Data Protection Authority, this is the supervisory authority in the field of privacy protection.
